## MassDOT Salt/Maintenance Facility Planned for Burlington Road in Bedford

We, the undersigned, oppose MassDOT's plan to locate a salt storage/maintenance facility **in a residential area** on Burlington Road (Route 62) due to the following potential impacts:

Environment/Public Health: Salt contamination in groundwater, Vine Brook and Shawsheen River

Environment/Public Health: Other (deicer/fuel) contamination of groundwater, Vine Brook and Shawsheen River

Environment: Threat to wildlife, including the endangered Bridle Shiner in Vine Brook

Environment: Tree clearing and ledge blasting

Environment: Increased Vine Brook flood risk due to loss of vegetation and soil Public Health: Air pollution due to idling diesel trucks and heavy equipment Immediately adjacent to neighborhood in residential zone

Location: Proximity to Wilson Mill Park (National Register of Historic Places)

Noise pollution: Trucks and heavy equipment

Noise pollution: Increased highway noise due to tree and ledge clearing

Light pollution: Operating and security lighting

Traffic: Congestion on Burlington Road, Route 3/62 interchange and Middlesex Turnpike

Traffic: Safety due to trucks entering and exiting facility from Burlington Road

Process: Lack of notice to neighbors and abutters
Process: Lack of alternate site consideration

Process: Lack of precedent for development of highway clover leafs

We demand that our elected officials take action to stop the proposed facility and/or that MassDOT identify an alternative location for the facility not adjacent to a residential neighborhood and wetlands.
